- responding to God's gifts of creation and Bible in Lent 2012

**An opportunity for Anglicans around the Communion to explore together two vital themes:**

1. Our understanding of and responsibility for creation
2. How Anglicans in different parts of the world use and interpret the Bible

**And it was good** is a **5-session course**, inviting Anglicans to walk together through the weeks of Lent, leading into Holy Week. It will be available as a printed booklet that can be purchased or as a free downloadable resource from the Anglican Communion website.

## Each Session contains:

- **BIBLE EXPLORATION** of one or two passages related to aspects of creation.
- **REFLECTION** on how our understanding can be deepened by the experiences of Anglican Christians throughout the world.
- **READING THE BIBLE WITH ANGLICANS AROUND THE WORLD**, reflecting on what our exploration suggests about the ways other Anglicans read the Bible.
- **QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION**
- **SHARING OUR INSIGHTS** with other Anglicans
- **CLOSING PRAYER**
